Peace in 10,000 Hands is the creation of New Zealand-born photographic artist Stuart Robertson. The project involves documenting a single white rose, an ancient symbol of peace held in the hands of 10,000 people from every country and walk of life. A number of global celebrities appear as subjects.

In winter 2017 a selection of iconic photographs from the Peace in 10,000 exhibitions will go under the hammer at a fundraising auction to be held at Te Takeretanga o Kura-hau-pō in Levin.

The auction will include three first edition 900mm by 900mm and one 330mm by 330mm originals. These pieces that have travelled with the exhibition will be auctioned alongside ten custom made one-of-a-kind artworks over 2m tall each, produced exclusively for Te Takeretanga o Kura-hau pō's exhibition.

Proceeds from the auction will go to Horowhenua charities working in the prevention, recovery and rehabilitation of victims, perpetrators and families affected by domestic violence.

Waka Wall Series

Unique to Te Takeretanga o Kura-hau-pō's exhibition, the Waka Wall panels are one-of-a-kind productions in the Peace in 10,000 Hands exhibition. This collection features notable celebrities alongside subjects from the far reaches of the globe, such as the untouched Highlands of Papua New Guinea. The panels are single piece latex on vinyl print, lustre laminated on 3mm ACM board (mounted by 8 screws). With measurements approximately 1080mm wide by 2350mm high they are the perfect stand out piece for your office, lobby, staircase or feature wall.



Item 6 **Bird of Paradise**



Fundraising for Muaupoko Tribal Authority. Supporting Whanau in education, prevention and resolution of domestic violence Compassionate Communication Wananga for families affected by violence.


