





# A quick guide to Lingogo, our app for bilingual Māori and Pasifika stories!

## What is Lingogo?

Lingogo is a free app where you can borrow bilingual Māori and Pasifika e-books, using your Libraries Horowhenua membership. Lingogo is part of our Libraries Horowhenua eLibrary.

Whether you're wanting to read for enjoyment, to learn and practise a language, or to feel closer to a culture, Lingogo can help. Lingogo is packed with Māori & Pasifika short stories. Lingogo uses a unique, interactive dual-language format to help readers of all ages and levels to access and enjoy their growing collection.

You can use Lingogo by downloading the app to your device of choice.

#### Who can use Lingogo?

Anyone with a Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership, and a suitable device. Lingogo is app based, so your device will need to be able to download apps.

#### What is needed?

- A Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership, with a password or pin set to it.
  - No fines exceeding the borrowing cap on the card.
- A suitable device and connection to Wi-Fi / internet, for downloading the app and logging in. You do not need Wi-Fi all the time, books will download and you can read them offline.

# How do you use Lingogo?

- Download Lingogo from the App Store (Apple) or the Play Store (Android) depending on your device.
- Open Lingogo, and select the Library. We are called **Horowhenua District** Libraries.
  - Use your card number and password or pin to log in.
  - If you do not know your card number or password, please contact info@horowhenua.govt.nz
    - Start browsing!
