eBooks, eAudiobooks, music, comics, graphic novels, movies and TV... hoopla has it all!

What is hoopla?

hoopla is an ePlatform or digital collection. You can use it to borrow eBooks, eAudibooks, music, comics, graphic novels, movies and TV. hoopla is part of our Libraries Horowhenua eLibrary.

You can enjoy **hoopla** via the downloadable app on your device of choice, in your computer's web browser, via Chromecast and Android TV, and with Android Auto.

Who can use hoopla?

Anyone with a Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership, and a suitable device. There is no cost, it is free with your library membership, and you can get 10 **hoopla** issues a month.

What is needed?

- A Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership, with a password or pin set to it.
 - No fines exceeding the borrowing cap on the card.
- A suitable device and connection to Wi-Fi / internet, for downloading the app and logging in. You don't need Wi-Fi all the time, issued items will download and you can enjoy them offline.

How do you use hoopla?

- Download hoopla from the App Store (Apple) or the Play Store (Android) or Amazon Appstore (Amazon Fire tablet) depending on your device.
 - You can also access hoopla from www.hoopladigital.co.nz
- Sign up to hoopla and create a login with your email, and choose a password. This is separate to your library card login and password.
 - You will now be able to select your library, we are under Libraries Horowhenua. Choose what email notifications you would like.
- Enter your Libraries Horowhenua card number and password/pin. It says pin but word-based passwords will work too.
 - If you do not know your card number or password, please contact info@horowhenua.govt.nz
 - Start browsing!

Enjoy!

- Search for eBooks, eAudiobooks, comics, music, movies and TV. Borrow items by clicking on the title icon and clicking borrow.
 - Stream the item or download it to your device to read, hear or watch it.
 - If you plan to use your item without Wi-Fi, you'll need to download it first.
- hoopla is very user friendly. No need to worry about overdues; items return themselves!
