

A quick guide to Cloud Library, our app and ePlatform for eBooks and eAudiobooks!

What is Cloud Library?

Cloud Library is an **ePlatform** or **digital collection**. You can use it to borrow eBooks and eAudiobooks with your Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership. **Cloud Library** is part of our **Libraries Horowhenua eLibrary**.

Reading digitally via eBooks or eAudiobooks has many benefits and great accessibility features!

You can enjoy **Cloud Library** via the downloadable app, or in your computer's web browser.

Who can use Cloud Library?

Anyone with a Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership, and a suitable device such as a smartphone, tablet, iPad, some eReaders, computer or laptop etc.

What is needed?

- A Libraries Horowhenua membership or eMembership, with a password or pin set to it.
 - No fines exceeding the borrowing cap on the card.
- A suitable device and connection to Wi-Fi / internet, for downloading the app and logging in. You don't need Wi-Fi all the time, issued items will download and you can read them offline.

How do you use **Cloud Library**?

• Download Cloud Library from the App Store (Apple) or the Play Store (Android) depending on your device.

- Open **Cloud Library**, select the country (New Zealand), the state/province (Manawatū- Whanganui) and our library. We are called **Horowhenua Libraries**.
 - Use your card number and password or pin to log in.
 - If you do not know your card number or password, please contact info@horowhenua.govt.nz
 - Start browsing!

Enjoy!

- You can issue eBooks and eAudiobooks using Cloud Library, or place holds if they're out.
- You can adjust font size, font type and background colours for ease of reading.
 - Cloud Library is very user friendly. No need to worry about overdues; items
 return themselves!
